AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 24, MOTOR VEHICLE CODE, ARTICLE III – STOP AND THROUGH STREETS, SECTION 24-3-2, SECTION 24-3-3, AND SECTION 23-3-4 AND ARTICLE VI – PARKING RULES, SECTION 24-6-3(C) OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF OBLONG, CRAWFORD COUNTY, ILLINOIS

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oblong, Crawford County, Illinois, that Chapter 24, Article III – STOP AND THROUGH STREETS, Section 24-3-2 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of Oblong, Illinois, be, and is hereby amended to include the following:

24-3-2 ONE-WAY STREETS OR ALLEYS. It shall be unlawful to operate any vehicle on any streets or alleys designated as one-way streets or alleys by ordinance in any direction other than that so designated. See Schedule “B” for the designated one-way streets and alleys.

SCHEDULE “B”
ONE-WAY STREETS

In accordance with Section 24-3-2 of this Chapter the following are established as “One Way Streets”:

<u>STREET (DIRECTION)</u>		<u>LOCATION</u>
Jefferson Street (South)	From	Main St. to Indiana St.
Indiana Street (West Bd.)	From	Washington St. to Jefferson St.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oblong, Crawford County, Illinois, that Chapter 24, Article III – STOP AND THROUGH STREETS, Section 24-3-3 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of Oblong, Illinois, be, and is hereby amended to include the following:

24-3-3 STOP STREETS. The driver of a vehicle shall stop in obedience to a stop sign at an intersection where a stop sign is erected pursuant to ordinance at one or more entrances thereto and shall proceed cautiously, yielding to the vehicles not so obliged to stop which are within the intersection or approaching so close as to constitute an immediate hazard, unless traffic at such intersection is controlled by a police officer on duty, in which event, the directions of the police officer shall be complied with. See Schedule “A” for the designated stop intersections.

SCHEDULE “A”
STOP INTERSECTIONS

In accordance with provisions of Section 24-3-1 and Section 24-3-3, the following are established as stop intersections:

I. ONE OR TWO-WAY STOPS.

III. FOUR-WAY STOPS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oblong, Crawford County, Illinois, that Chapter 24, Article III – STOP AND THROUGH STREETS, Section 24-3-4 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of Oblong, Illinois, be, and is hereby amended to include the following:

24-3-4 YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY STREETS. The driver of a vehicle approaching a yield sign, in obedience to such sign, shall slow down to a speed reasonable for the existing conditions and if required for safety to stop, shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or if none, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway. After slowing or stopping, the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching on another roadway so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard during the time such driver is moving across or within the intersection. SCHEDULE “C”

YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY STREETS

In accordance with Section 24-3-4, the following are designated as yield right-of-way intersections:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oblong, Crawford County, Illinois, that Chapter 24, Article VI – PARKING RULES, Section 24-6-3(C) of the Revised Code of Ordinances of Oblong, Illinois, be, and is hereby amended to include the following:

24-6-3 STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING PROHIBITED IN SPECIFIED PLACES.

(C) Schedules “E”, “F” and “G” shall list all applicable no-parking zones.

SCHEDULE “E”
NO PARKING

In accordance with provisions of Section 24-6-3(C) of this Chapter the following are established as “No Parking Zones”:

<u>STREET (DIRECTION)</u>		<u>LOCATION</u>
W. Missouri St. (North)	From	S. Range St. to Alley
S. Range St. (East Only)	From	Corporate Limit to Main St.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof shall upon conviction be subject to a fine or not less than \$75.00 or more than \$750.00 and the cost of prosecution.

All of the other terms and provisions of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the Village of Oblong, Crawford County, Illinois, shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
