**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24 - MOTOR VEHICLE,  
ARTICLE III- STOP AND THROUGH STREETS, SECTION 3 STOP  
STREETS, SECTION 4 YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY STREETS, AND  
ARTICLE IV- DRIVING RULES, SECTION 2 (F) GENERAL SPEED  
RESTRICTIONS OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE VILLAGE OF OBLONG, CRAWFORD COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF  
TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OBLONG, ILLINOIS, THAT THE  
FOLLOWING WORDING BE ADDED TO CHAPTER 24:**

**24-3-3 STOP STREETS.** The driver of a vehicle shall stop in obedience to a stop sign at an intersection where a stop sign is erected pursuant to ordinance at one or more entrances thereto and shall proceed cautiously, yielding to the vehicles not so obliged to stop which are within the intersection or approaching so close as to constitute an immediate hazard, unless traffic at such intersection is controlled by a police officer on duty, in which event, the directions of the police officer shall be complied with. See **Schedule “A”** for designated stop intersections. (See 625 ILCS Sec. 5/11-302)

*Any person receiving a citation under this Article shall pay the fine provided for in this section at the police station or Village Clerk’s office within fourteen days from the date of the citation. If any penalty is not paid within that fourteen-day period, the police chief or the village attorney is authorized to file a complaint alleging the violation of this Ordinance and issue a notice to appear requiring the person to whom the citation was issued to appear in the Crawford County Circuit Court to answer the charge. Nothing in this section shall preclude the Village of Oblong, its police department, or other attorney from taking or pursuing any action allowed by law as a result of the violation or from referring the matter to another entity for prosecution as allowed by law.*

**24-3-4 YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY STREETS.** The driver of a vehicle approaching a yield sign, in obedience to such sign, shall slow down to a speed reasonable for the existing conditions and if required for safety to stop, shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or if none, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway. After slowing or stopping, the driver shall yield the right-off-way to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching on another roadway so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard during the time such driver is moving across or within the intersection (**See Schedule “C”**)

*Any person receiving a citation under this Article shall pay the fine provided for in this section at the police station or Village Clerk's office within fourteen days from the date of the citation. If any penalty is not paid within that fourteen-day period, the police chief or the village attorney is authorized to file a complaint alleging the violation of this Ordinance and issue a notice to appear requiring the person to whom the citation was issued to appear in the Crawford County Circuit Court to answer the charge. Nothing in this section shall preclude the Village of Oblong, its police department, or other attorney from taking or pursuing any action allowed by law as a result of the violation or from referring the matter to another entity for prosecution as allowed by law.*

#### **24-4-2 DRIVING RULES.**

**(F) General Speed Restrictions.** The speed limits on the various streets shall be approved by the Village Board, but shall not exceed **twenty miles per hour (20 MPH)** in a school zone and not to exceed **twenty-five miles per hour (25 MPH)** on a residential street; otherwise, **thirty miles per hour (30 MPH)** on an arterial street unless otherwise posted. (See Schedule "D") (See 625 ILCS Sec. 5/11-604) (See 65 ILCS Sec. 5/11-40-1)

##### *State Speed Laws (Speeding)*

*The state traffic laws regulating the speed of vehicles shall be applicable upon all streets within the Village of Oblong, except on West and East Main St where it is deemed state property. All Village streets are applicable in regards to speeding violations in accordance to this code. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a vehicle at a speed in excess of any speed so declared by posted signage that are in place giving notice. No person shall operate a vehicle on any of the streets within the Village of Oblong at a greater speed than that specified by signage.*

*Any person receiving a citation under this Article shall pay the fine provided for in this section at the police station or Village Clerk's office within fourteen days from the date of the citation. If any penalty is not paid within that fourteen-day period, the police chief or the village attorney is authorized to file a complaint alleging the violation of this Ordinance and issue a notice to appear requiring the person to whom the citation was issued to appear in the Crawford County Circuit Court to answer the charge. Nothing in this section shall preclude the Village of Oblong, its police department, or other attorney from taking or pursuing any action allowed by law as a result of the violation or from referring the matter to another entity for prosecution as allowed by law.*

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on July 11, 2018.
