ORDINANCE NO. 2019-O-601

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 27, OFFENSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board of the Village of Oblong, Crawford County, Illinois, that CHAPTER 27, OFFENSES, of the Revised Codes of Ordinances of Oblong, Illinois, be, and the same is hereby amended to be as follows:

Tobacco and Electronic Smoking Devices

(a) Definitions. For the purpose of this article, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them:

Tobacco products: Any substance containing tobacco leaf, including, by not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco or dipping tobacco nicotine gels and dissolvable nicotine products or any electronic smoking device.

Electronic smoking device: An electronic and/or battery-operated device, the use of which may resemble smoking, which can be used to deliver an inhaled dose of nicotine or other regulated substances. "Electronic smoking device" includes any such device, whether manufactured, distributed, marketed, or sold as an electronic cigarette, an electronic cigar, an electronic cigarillo, an electronic pipe, an electronic hookah, hookah pen, vape pens or any other product name or descriptor. An electronic smoking device excludes any product approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration as a nontobacco product used for medicinal purposes and is being marketed and sold solely for that approved purpose.

(b) Purchases by minors prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to purchase tobacco products or electronic smoking devices, or to misrepresent their identity or age, or to use any false or altered identification for the purpose of purchasing tobacco products and electronic smoking devices.

(c) Possession by minors prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to possess any tobacco products or electronic smoking devices, provided that the possession by a person under the age of eighteen (18) years under the direct supervision of the parent or guardian of such person in the privacy of the parent's or guardian's home shall not be prohibited.

(d) Use in Village Park. It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke tobacco products and electronic smoking devices within ten (10) feet of any permanent seating facility, any pavilion, any equipment/structure and restrooms in the Oblong Village Park.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person violating any provision of this Ordinance, or any rule or regulation adopted or used pursuant thereto, or any provision of this Ordinance adopted herein by reference, shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not less than One hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Seven hundred Fifty dollars (\$750.00), and the

costs of prosecution and the attorney's fees of the Village in a minimum amount of One hundred Seventy-five dollars (\$175.00) per hour.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
