ORDINANCE NO. 2023-643

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 "ANIMALS" OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF OBLONG, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Oblong, Illinois is an Illinois non-home rule municipal corporation pursuant to Article VII, § 8 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution, organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of each municipality may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper. 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OBLONG, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1: Amendment. The following exhibit shall amend Section 3-1-9(B) of "**The Revised Code of Ordinances**" of the Village of Oblong, Illinois" and shall be as follows:

SECTION 2: Severability of Provisions. Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 3: Conflicting Ordinances. Any conflicting ordinances, code provisions or pertinent portions thereof in effect at the time this ordinance takes effect are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

SECTION 4: Passed this 12th day of December, 2023 by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Oblong, Illinois, and deposited and filed in the office of the Village Clerk in said Village on that date.

LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF DOGS AND CATS KEPT.

Limitation; Exception.

- (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep more than **three (3) dogs** and/or **cats** within the Village, with the exception that a litter of pups, a litter of kittens or a portion of a litter may be kept for a period of time not exceeding **five (5) months** from birth.
- (2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any establishment wherein dogs or cats are kept for breeding, sale, sporting purposes or boarding.
